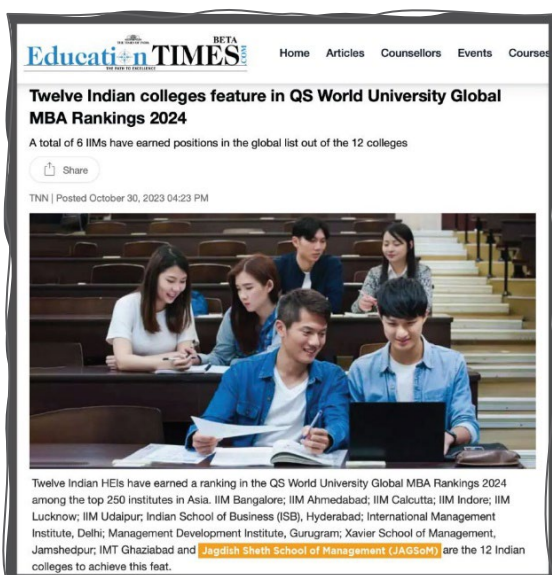

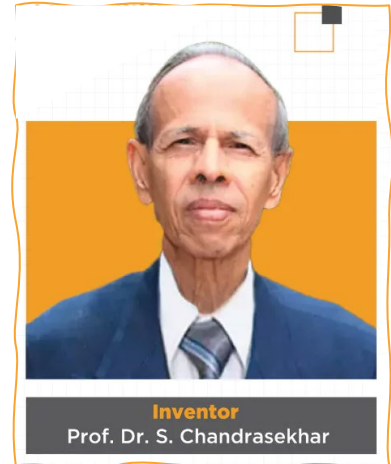

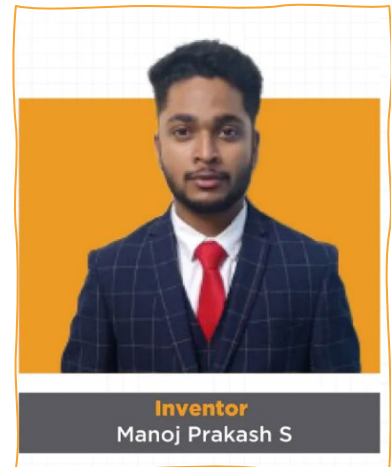
Corporate Credit Rating

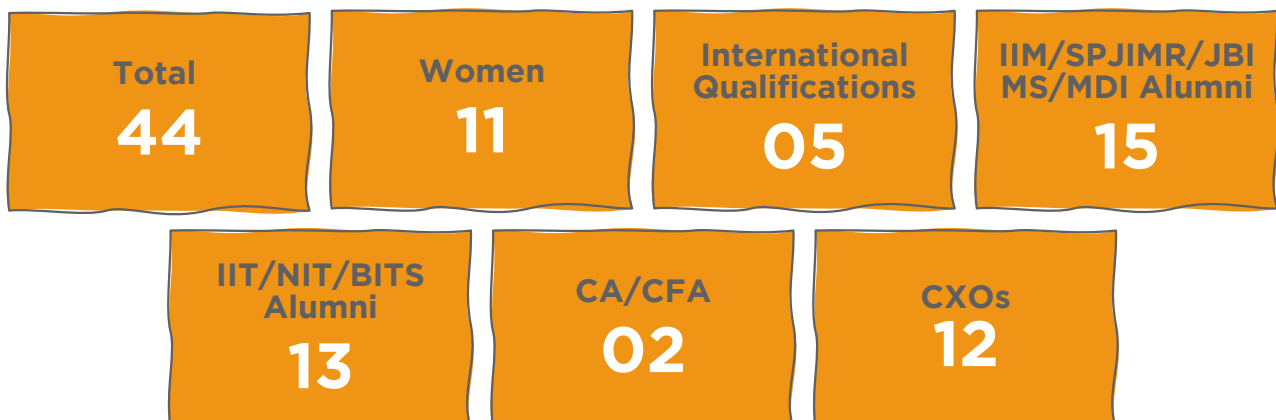
The Compendium

DESIGN THINKING

The Design Thinking course at JAGSoM is a practice course that precedes the Innovation Incubation and Research Incubation courses. JAGSoM students are coached to apply design thinking principles to solve business problems. The course culminated in the Design Thinking Exhibition (DTE) which was held in the JAGSoM campus on the 17th of February 2024.

JAGSoM student teams, under the guidance of Dr. Kamalika Chakraborty, Prof. Rohit Swarup and Prof. Romita Swarup, JAGSoM Faculty, presented their innovative ideas as part of their Design Thinking practice course.. The student groups were judged by a Jury comprising of Mr. Sumved Shami, Co-Founder, Visdam Labs and Mr. Chandrashekhar D, Founder CEO at Clinault Consumer (D2C) & Unikelvin Ventures. 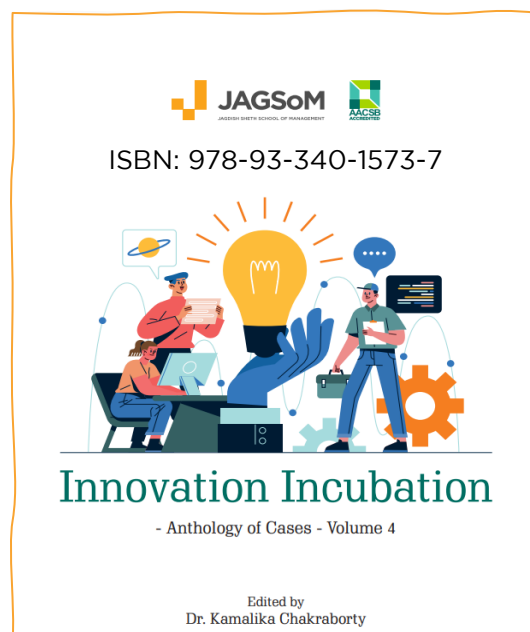

INNOVATION INCUBATION

STUDENT MANAGED INVESTMENT FUND (SMIF)

The Student Managed Investment Fund (SMIF) at JAGSoM consists of a corpus of 1.5 Million Rupees and is completely managed by students from the Finance Area in real time, creating a portfolio of a set of equity and structured products.

The Investments in the Fund have been carried out in the Automobile, Capital goods, Chemicals, and Retail sectors to name a few. The SMIF has generated superior returns, even when compared to the Large and Mid-Cap Category Average, Mirae Asset Large Cap Direct plan, other AMCs and the BSE 200 index.

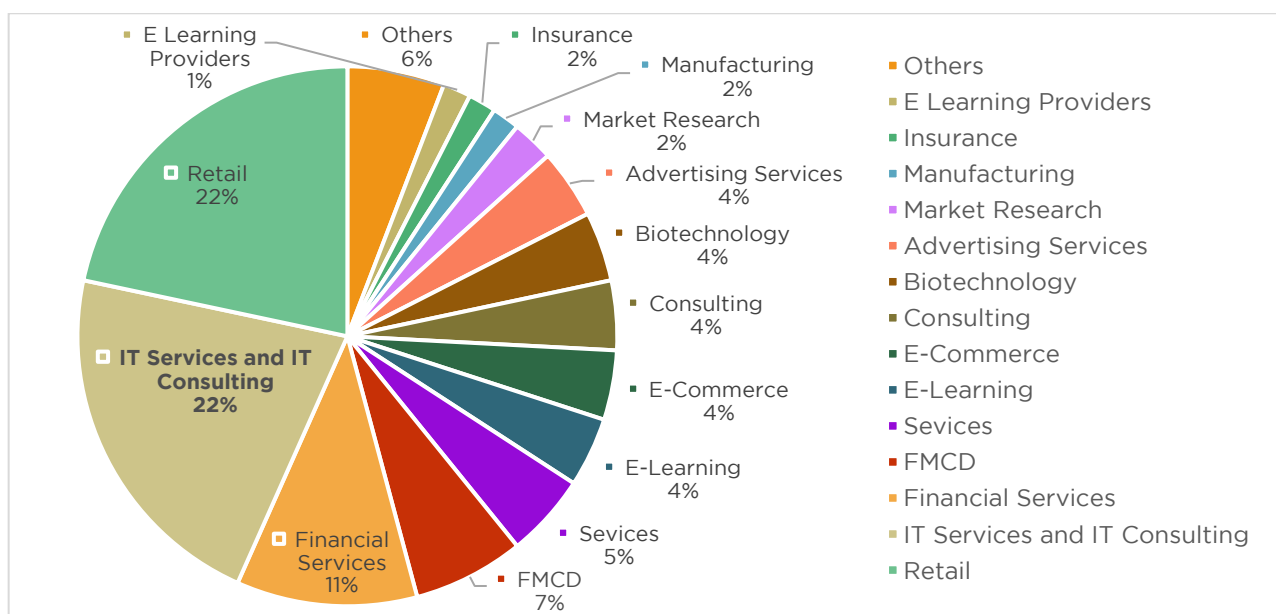

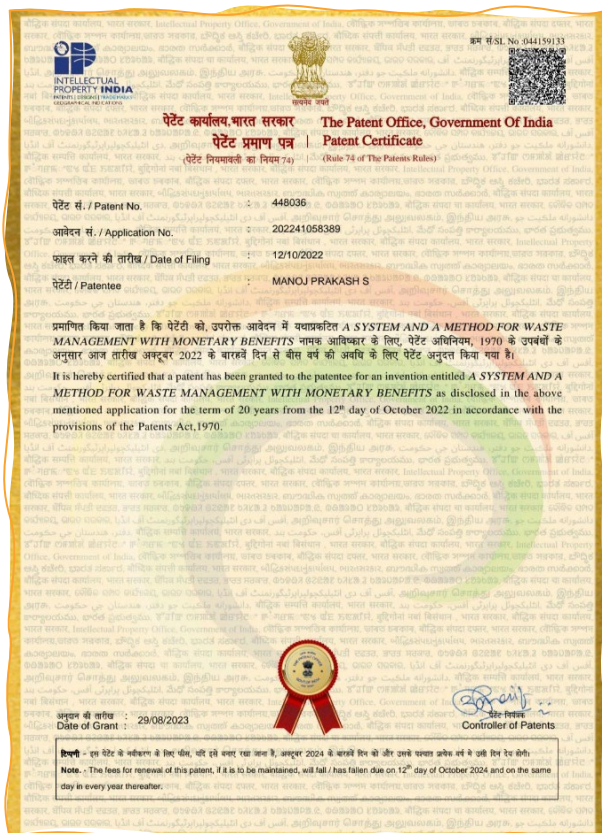

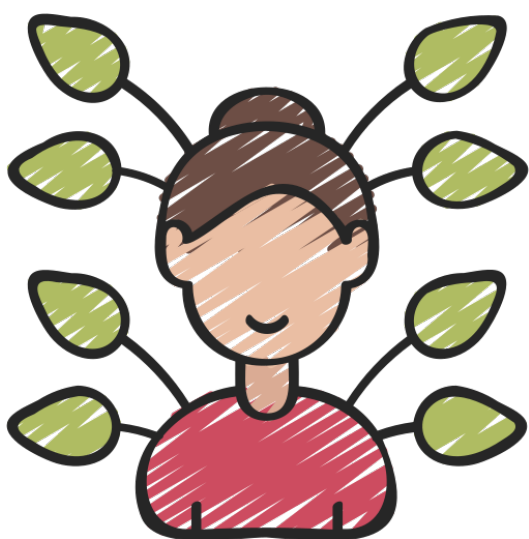
JAGSoM students take part in a diverse variety of extra-curriculum activities and competitions, winning a number of accolades over the past year.

OUTBOUND LEADERSHIP LAB (OLL)

JAGSoM's goal is to ensure Learner Success through its unique five-step process so that they are well-rounded, socially aware, and are continuously employable throughout their careers. The Outbound Leadership Lab (OLL) is part of the First Step, i.e. **Self-Discovery** which focuses on helping students understand themselves better. EFFECTIVE EXECUTION (EE)

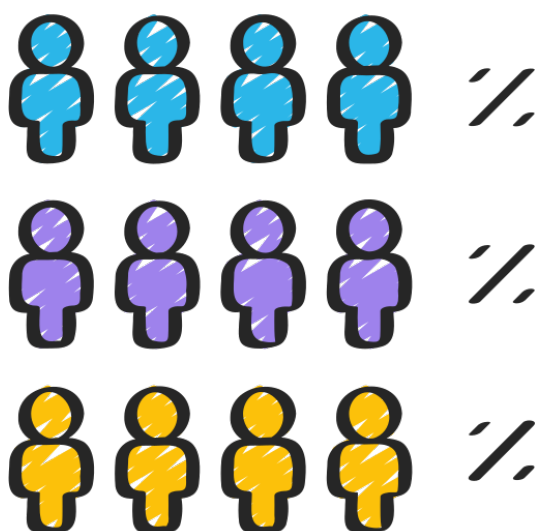
This course aims to improve students' skills in collaboration, conflict resolution, and in executing critical tasks efficiently and cost-effectively in order to achieve Institution building milestones.

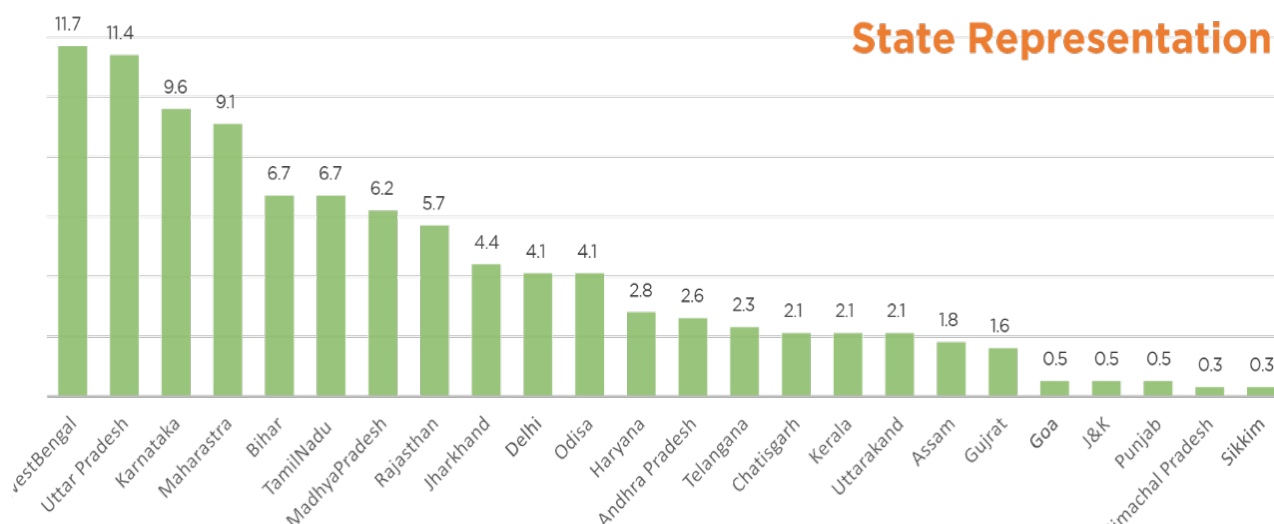

Gender Ratio

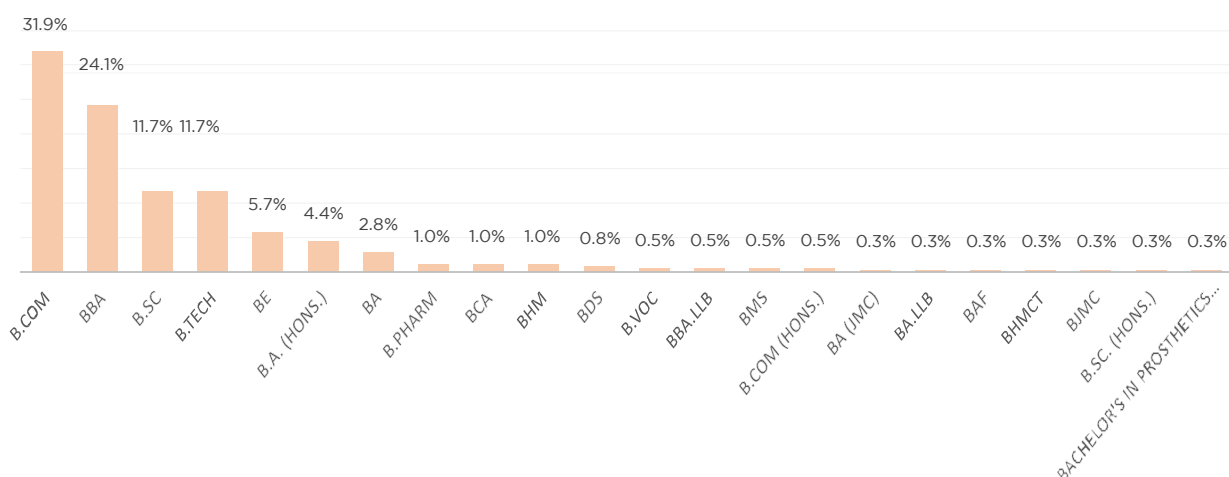


Engineering Vs Non - Engineering Graduate

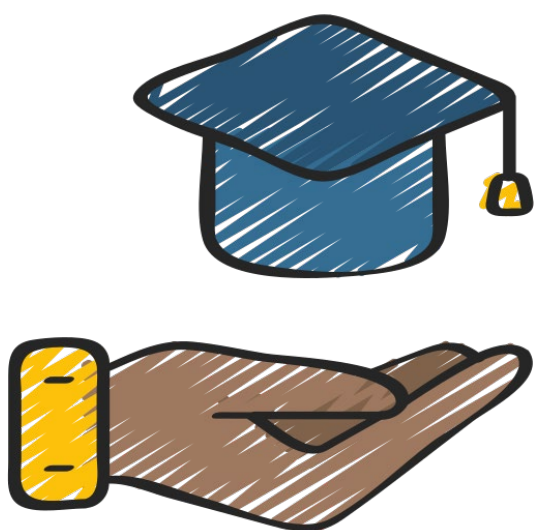
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FOUNDER'S DAY 2024

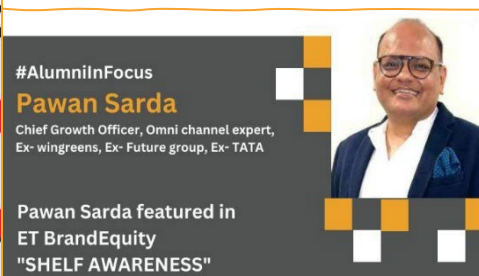

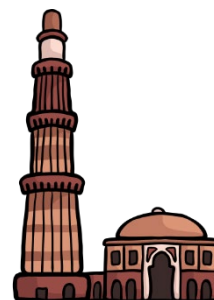
